Got a problem with late payments and fees? Condo fees are due on the first of the month. The Leisure World Accounting Department posts payments to your account on the date they are received. Payments received after the 15th of the month - even by one day - are considered delinquent, incurring a late fee of \$30.00. Don't ignore those letters, and don't expect *us* to call *you*. Call 301-598-1078 (not me) and our new Mutual Accountant, Frank Adams, will try to get you straightened out. It's your responsibility to pay the fee or submit proof of timely payment to the Board with a written request for a waiver.

Notes From The Board

The Board approved a proposal to power wash patio home siding, entry ramps in the apartment buildings and atriums. The Mutual will try to notify residents in advance.

Also approved was the proposal for four patio homes to have full or partial replacement of driveways.

New emergency lights will be installed in the apartment buildings. Our insurance company advisor found a number of lights were not working and should be replaced.

The insurance adjuster also saw fire pits and grills too close to the back of some patio homes. Montgomery County regulations state that open flame grills and fire pits must be <u>at least 20 feet away</u> from the building or home.

The next phase of construction of the new Administration building will involve taking up more parking spaces and also digging across Leisure World Blvd for utility work.

It was brought to the Board's attention that there are a number of patio enclosures with windows that have fogged up. These need to be replaced. The Board was asked to take action. Letters will be sent to the owners.
